



HIKING AND BIRD – WATCHING

CASA LIONARDO RECOMMENDS :

Lovers of nature and photography as well as birdwatchers will certainly enjoy excursions in the Fucecchio Marsh, a wide wetland inhabited by colonies of herons and other aquatic species that here they found their ideal habitat.

The nature reserve is the largest internal Italian marsh, about 2.000 hectares, between the Valdinievole and Montalbano.

The Padule plays a fundamental role in the migratory routes between the Tyrrhenian coast and the interior, hosting during the year over 200 different species of birds.

Those interested in birdwatching can immerse themselves in nature by following free or guided paths.
